

USCA Student Summer Housing Information

1. Eligibility for Summer Housing

- a. You must be an accepted or continuing USCA student, but **you do not have to be enrolled in summer classes** to live on campus during the summer!

2. Summer Housing Reservations:

- a. Interested students must pick up the Summer 2009 USCA Student Housing Application & Contract from any Area Office within University Housing. Applications & Contract will be available on March 9th, 2009.
- b. Students seeking Summer Housing must complete and sign this form prior to the summer session they wish to reserve a room for. Completed applications must be turned into the Central Office in Pacer Commons 200.
- c. Only new students to University Housing must submit \$150 (security deposit & non-refundable application fee) prior to check-in.
- d. Students have the option of requesting a double or single room assignment. Single rooms are granted based on space availability for the summer and are not guaranteed.

3. Changes/Cancellation of Contract

All changes and/or cancellations to this contract must be made in writing via fax (803-641-3785) or email (housing@usca.edu) no later than 3 days prior to student's reservation check-in date. Failure to cancel Summer Housing requests will result in the student remaining responsible for the associated housing fees (full session prices).

4. Assignments

- a. All summer students will be housed in Pacer Commons.
- b. Assignments will be made by University Housing and requests for specific roommates will be considered, but are not guaranteed.
- c. All students should anticipate having to move at least once during the summer months. Students will be given at least 2 days advanced notice of when their new assignment is available.

5. Summer Housing Sessions and Rates

Summer Term:	Rates (Double/Single):
Maymester (May 11 - May 27):	\$245/\$300
Summer I (June 1 - July 2):	\$425/\$480
Summer II (July 6 - August 6):	\$425/\$480

6. University Housing and USCA Policies

- a. All USCA and University Housing policies contained within the 2008-2009 Community Guide book, contract and USCA Student Handbook, will remain in effect throughout the summer. Failure to comply may result in immediate removal. It is the resident's responsibility to be familiar with these policies.

7. Check-out Process

- a. All students, except those who are staying for Maymester, are required to checkout at the end of the Spring semester. Those students assigned for Summer II session who are not staying for the 2009-2010 school year must vacate University Housing by August 7th by 5:00 pm.
